Camping information

Dear Festival Campers,

We hope you're getting excited for Free Your Mind Kingsday! To ensure you have a fantastic experience, we've put together some essential information regarding your camping experience. Please take a moment to review the following details:

Check-in and Check-out Times:

You can check in at the following times only. Please note that these are the only times you can enter the camping area. You are allowed to leave the camping area during opening hours to access your vehicle or for other necessities, but once inside the festival grounds, you cannot return to the camping area.

Friday, April 26, 2024: 10:00 AM – 12:00 AM Saturday, April 27, 2024: 12:00 PM – 12:00 AM

Sunday, April 28, 2024: 12:00 PM

The camping area closes at 12:30 AM on both days. Please ensure you have everything you need before this time, as re-entry is not permitted unless under exceptional circumstances, approved by a staff member or security personnel.

Check-out time on Sunday, April 28, 2024, is 12:00 PM. All campers must vacate the camping area by this time.

Camping Hosts:

Our friendly hosts will be available 24/7 throughout the duration of the festival to assist you with any queries or concerns you may have.

Access Policy and Identification:

Free Your Mind Kingsday camping is strictly for individuals aged 18 and above. Please ensure you bring a valid form of identification, as you will be asked for it upon entry. Individuals who are visibly under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs will be denied entry, as per our security protocols. Please note that we cannot reimburse camping tickets, travel expenses, or any other incurred costs in such cases.

Weekend Wristband:

Upon display of your camping ticket at the entrance, you will receive a special festival wristband, which grants you access to the camping area.

Strict Enforcement:

All attendees are expected to adhere to the Free Your Mind Kingsday and camping site rules, which can be found on our website and displayed on banners at the entrance. Deliberate violations of these rules will result in removal from the terrain by security and depending on the severity of the offence, the police may intervene.

Glass, Cans, and Beverages:

Glass containers are strictly prohibited throughout the camping area. Plastic and canned beverages are permitted. Upon arrival, each person may bring up to 6 liters of low-alcoholic beverages, packaged in plastic or cans. Once you have received your wristband, you cannot bring additional beverages inside.

Campsite Facilities:

We've arranged various activities and amenities at the Free Your Mind Kingsday camping site to enhance your experience, including a camping store and an information desk. Please refer to the info guide provided upon entry for the opening hours of these facilities.

Camping rules

With Kingsday just around the corner, we're looking forward to welcoming you to the Free Your Mind Kingsday Camping! To ensure everyone has a fantastic weekend, we'd like to share some important rules with you. Please read them carefully and respect them during your stay at the festival grounds and campsite.

Here are the key points to keep in mind:

- **Zero Tolerance Policy:** The use of mind-altering substances, weapons, or strong alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited. We conduct searches upon arrival, so please ensure you don't bring any prohibited items.
- Music: Personal sound systems are not allowed. You can bring a small Bluetooth speaker, but make sure the volume isn't too loud to avoid causing disturbance.
- Waste Management: Respect nature and dispose of waste in designated bins. Take all your personal belongings with you when leaving the premises and do not leave behind tents or trash.
- **Violence and Intimidation:** These behaviors are not tolerated, including discrimination, sexual harassment, or provocative clothing. Let's keep it friendly and respectful for everyone.
- **Smoking:** Smoking is not allowed in the festival tents and is discouraged in tents due to fire hazards.
- **Drinking:** Enjoy your drinks, but keep it enjoyable and respect others. Appropriate measures will be taken against visitors who harass others.
- **Trading:** Trading in any form is prohibited.
- Audio and Video Cameras: Professional audio and video equipment is not allowed without written permission from the organizers.
- Grounds: Do not dig trenches, holes, or pits, as this is prohibited.
- **Emergency Exits:** Blocking emergency exits is strictly prohibited and will be removed immediately.
- **Items to Leave at Home:** Please review the list of prohibited items carefully and ensure you do not bring them to prevent confiscation.

Camping rules

The following items are prohibited on the festival grounds and camping site:

- Drugs, Medication (unless accompanied by a doctor's prescription), Laughing gas, Laughing gas cartridges
- Gas cylinders, Gas appliances, Torches, Charcoal BBQs, Lamp oil, Fireworks, Confetti, Graffiti, Advertising materials, Candles, (Fire)arms, Knives (except for eating utensils)
- Sound systems, Professional cameras, Walkie Talkies, Selfie sticks
- Laser pens, Umbrellas, Pets
- Generators, or any other power generators.
- Stoves, refrigerators, tap installations, and gas bottles. (small disposable BBQs are allowed)
- Spirits, beverages with an alcohol percentage of 15% or more are not allowed
- Glassware, including glass bottles
- Sofas and other household items
- Confetti and party poppers
- Football shirts and/or clothing with nationalist symbols or expressions
- It is not allowed to leave the camping area between 00:30 and 10:00
- Carts or other means of transport for luggage that do not fit through the access gates in a normal way
- Dry ice, (laughing) gas cartridges, etc.
- Graffiti, spray cans, paint pots, waterproof markers, etc.
- Pets, as much as we love them, including your faithful dog, fish, or parrot, should be left at home
- Anything that can create noise; sound systems, vuvuzelas, etc.
- Any form of open fire including bonfires, torches, fireworks, etc.
